**LOCAL FCFC CORE RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- **Community Capacity Building/Planning:** strategies and outcomes  
Increase the number of activities available for youth to prevent and reduce the use of drugs and alcohol with our youth.
- **Service Coordination:** strategies and outcomes  
Create schools that work for every child. Intensive service coordination is provided in the high schools for students and their families.
- **Family Empowerment:** strategies and outcomes  
Increase parent participation on council by parent reps recruiting new parent reps.
- **Early Childhood System of Care:** strategies and outcomes  
ECCC and the Social Service Council meet bi-monthly to addresses gaps in services for families with young children. This group is comprised of families who receives services throughout the county and many front line workers.

**OTHER LOCAL INITIATIVES: strategies and outcomes**

Pilot county participating in the Maternal Depression Pilot Project.

**FUNDING:**

Vinton County FCFC is funding solely with the \$20,000.00 from the Occupational Capacity Building Fund.

Part time FCFC coordinator
